become a good reader and writer!**

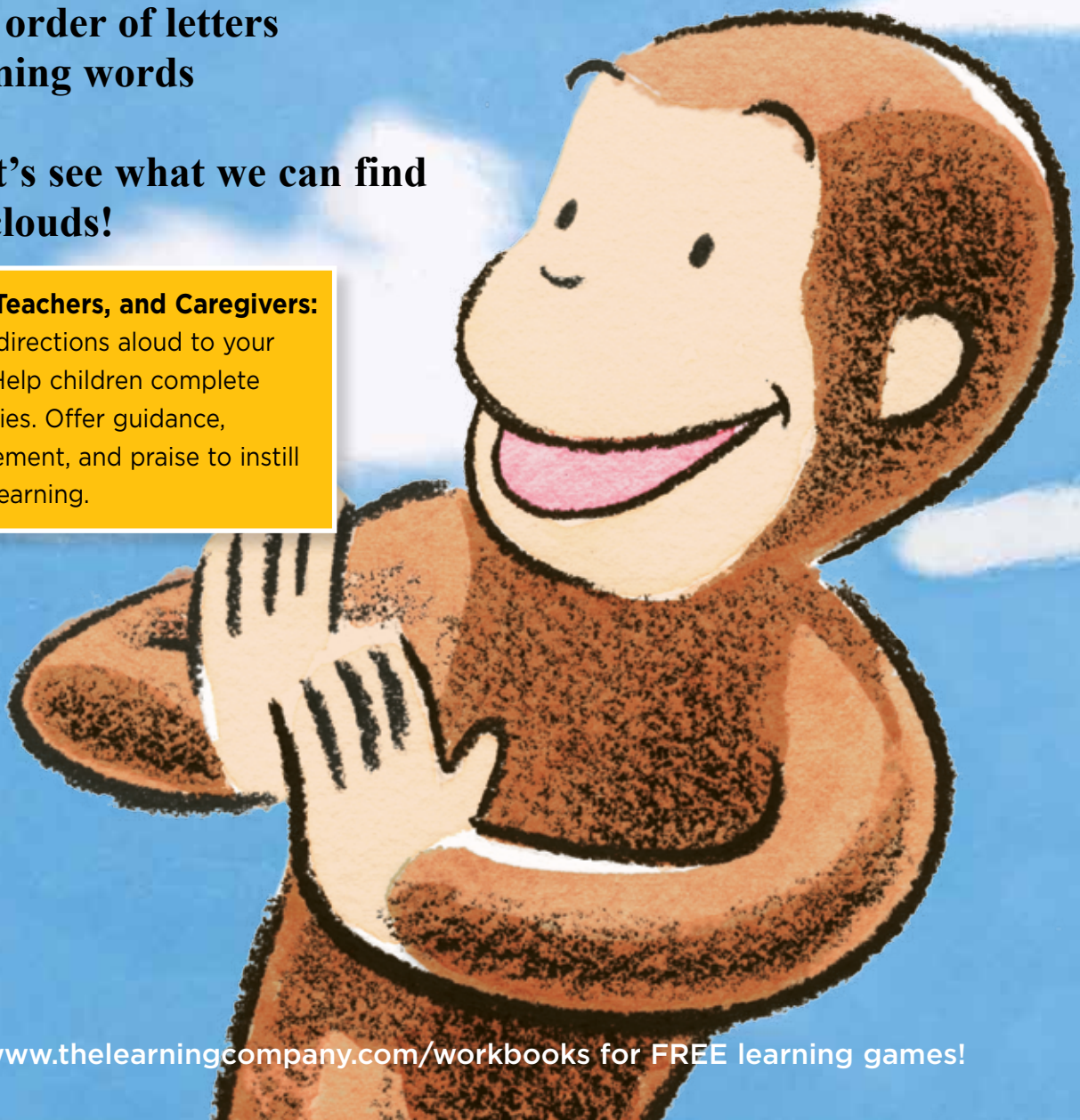

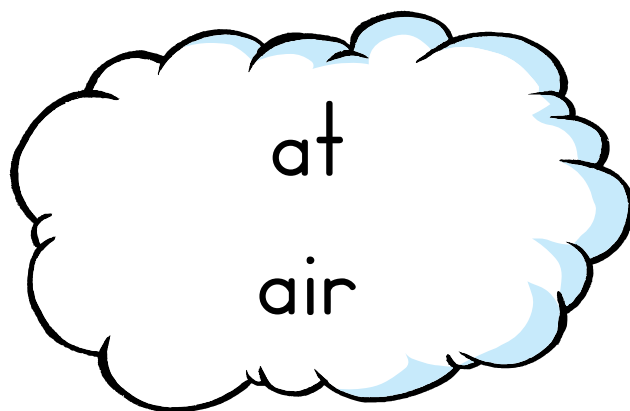
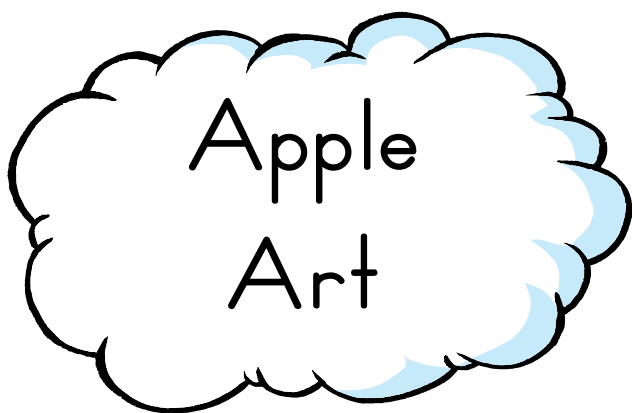


The Letter A

Trace the dotted lines on the capital and lowercase letter A's.

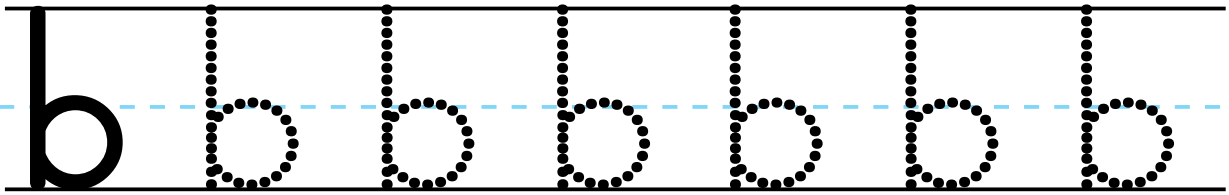
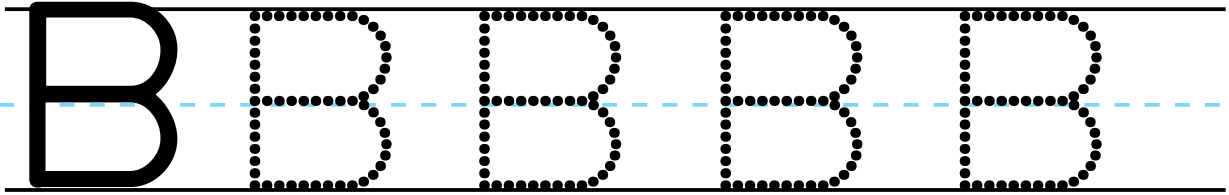


Underline all the letter *a*'s in the words below.

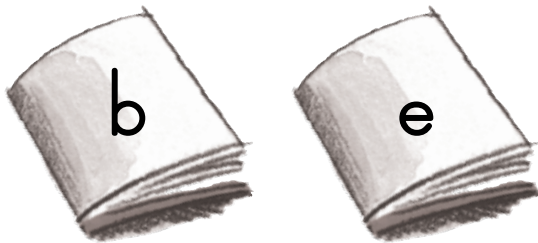


The Letter B

Trace the dotted lines on the capital and lowercase letter *B*'s.

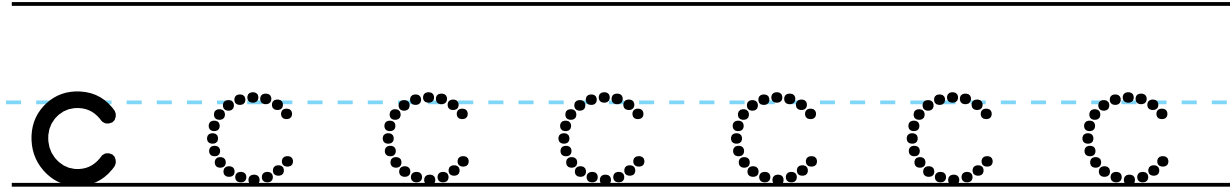
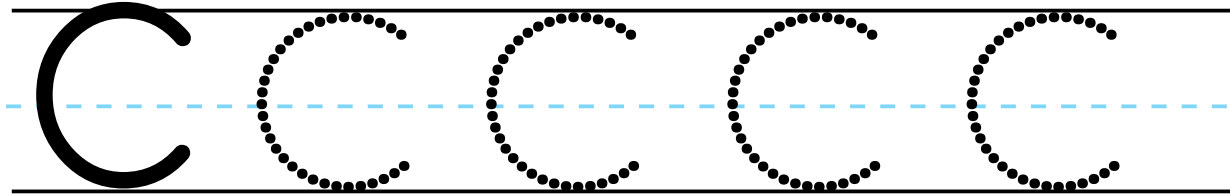


Color the books that have the letter *b* on them.

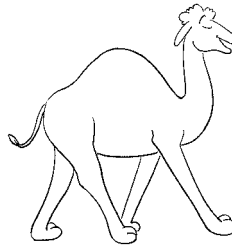


The Letter C

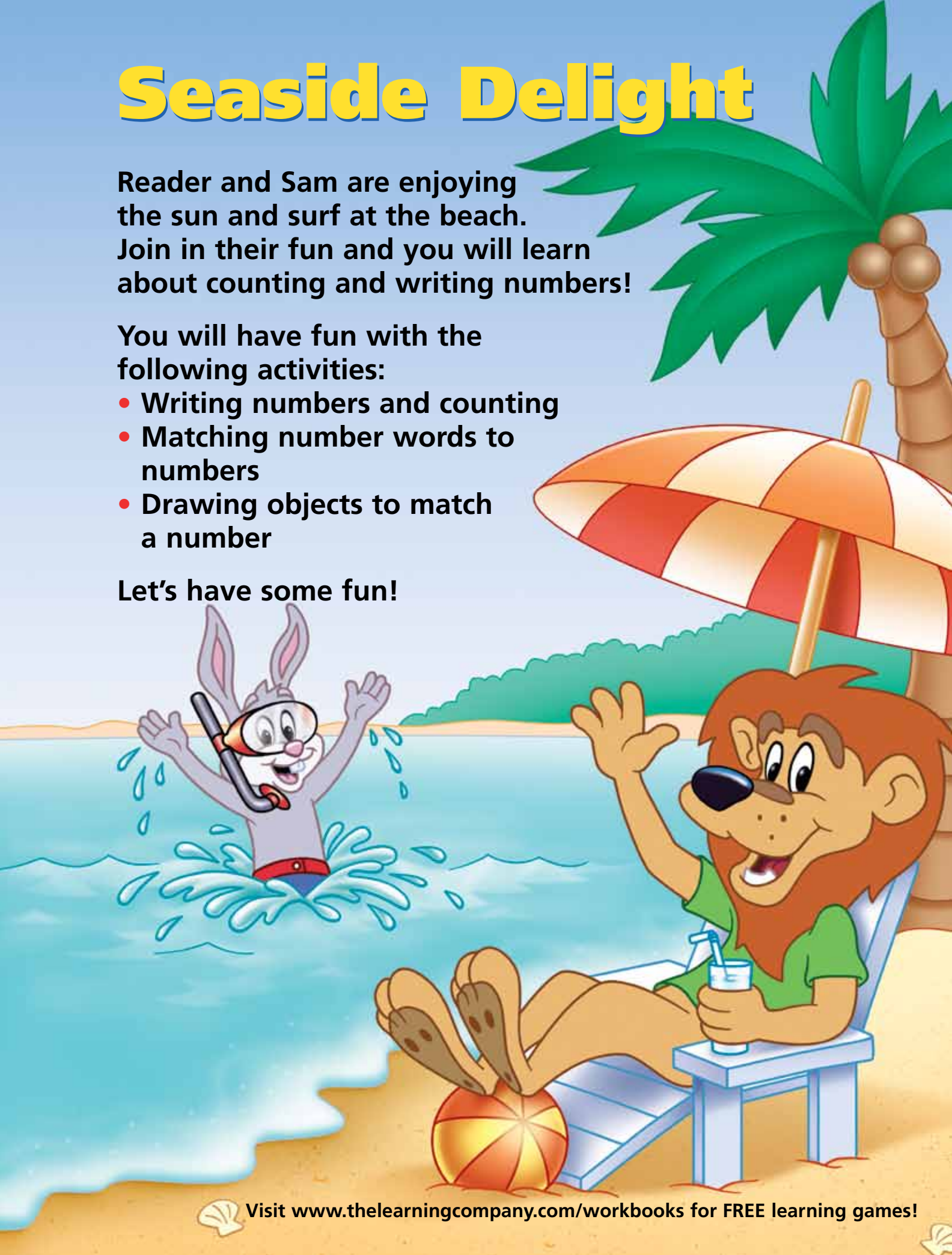
Seaside Delight
